2014 marked a year of major changes to the Services namely through the enactment of our new governing legislation – *Tonga Fire and Emergency Services Act 2014*. This enactment by default resulted in a change of name from 'Tonga Fire Services' to Tonga Fire and Emergency Services. This new name is a testament of the direction in which the Services is heading and its service delivery to the Kingdom, Government and people of Tonga. It is highlighted that under Section 8(4) of the Tonga Fire and Emergency Services Act 2014, all members of the Services "shall be vested with all the powers and privileges of a police officer for the purposes of the Tonga Police Act".

The establishment of a new specialised division – 'Emergency Response Division' was created and was put to the test with the natural disasters that affected our country in 2014. Notably, the Services introduced our very webpage for ease of reference of the community and our international partners.

Unfortunately, we lost our Fire Station situated at Pangai, Ha'apai during the Category 5 Tropical Cyclone Ian that caused havoc when it descended upon the Ha'apai Islands in January 2015.

However, I am proud to be the Fire and Emergency Commissioner of this Service and to work among dedicated firemen and woman. On behalf of all staff, I wish to acknowledge and appreciate the working relationship that we share with the Government of Tonga and the Government of South Australia. May we continue to work in unison for the benefit of people of Tonga.

Our Organisation

The Tonga Fire & Emergency Services (TFES) has been acknowledged for coordinating and carrying out proactive fire prevention and responding to fire and other emergency calls. We are committed to continuously improving the services that we provide to the community and the people in the Kingdom of Tonga. We aim to be recognised not just as an excellent emergency responder but also as an agency that reduces risks to the community that provides our people with the services they need, that is effectively managed and governed, and that provides excellent value.

The TFES Statement of Corporate Intent has been prepared and summarises the Services objectives for the period covered by the Corporate Plan. This new corporate plan of the Service – TFES is aligned with high level Government objectives including the TSDF II national outcome objectives. The TFES programmes and sub-programmes are designed to improve the functions and service delivery of the Service.

Currently there are a total of five (5) divisions which staffs operate under. They are:


- Administration & Corporate Services Division;
- Training and Development Division:
- Emergency Response Division;
- Community Safety Division; and
- Operations and Suppression Division.

In pursuant to the Corporate Plan 2015/2016 - 2017/2018 – these 5 divisions are broken down into four (4) sub-programmes for the purposes of operating its own budget for their expected project delivery.

The TFES primary purpose is to minimise the social, economic and environmental impact of fire and other emergencies in our community. This will be achieved through implementing strategies to develop community self-reliance to prevent and prepare for fires, supported by a timely and effective response to emergencies.

The TFES is also responsible for road accident rescue, natural disasters, managing incidents involving hazardous materials and undertaking urban search and rescue (USAR).

The year 2014 presented many changes including the enactment of our principle legislation which will set the pathway for future developments.


With the solidification of emergencies in our service delivery, the Services established an Emergency Response Division (ERD) which is made up of staff with specialised technical skills that would be of assistance in times of an emergency response.

Although we have five (5) divisions, these have been allocated across 4 Sub – Programmes which is illustrated on the 'TFES Strategic Map'. The Strategic Map indicates our aims and missions and what we as a Service strides to deliver.

We aim to work cohesively with other emergency responders to further improve our interoperability. To achieve this, we are striving towards a common doctrine across emergency responder agencies that also deal with emergency response.



The executive administration of TFES is led by the Minister for Police, Fire & Emergency Services, and Prisons and supported by the Fire and Emergency Commissioner. They hold external and internal responsibilities linked to the performance indicators. Externally, the Service's Executive Officers are responsible for supervising and providing appropriate advice and guidance on management of the Services.

Within the Service, the Minister is responsible for providing leadership and political direction necessary for the delivery of the Ministry's programs and sub-programs. The Fire and Emergency Commissioner manages the administration, development, and implementation of the Service's sub-programs and provides necessary leadership to the staff.

At the divisional level, each program is managed by a Fire Commander (Officer Commanding) whose performances are measured by respective divisional outputs.


Fire and Emergency Commissioner, Heimuli, L is second in command and administrated the Service and had the responsibility for the general efficiency and daily operations throughout the year.

Tonga Fire and Emergency Services Act 2014

Since the Tonga Fire Services was established, the Services were governed by the Tonga Fire Service Act 1978. The Act covered the administrative and operational process of the Services that was efficient at the time.

Most notably, this era was when the Tonga Fire Services was still amalgamated and under the administration of Tonga Police. Since the two Services parted administrative and financial systems in 2010_there was a need to revise the 1978 Act as it was not adaptable with the changing times.

Tongan Society was rapidly changing; more international training opportunities were readily available for staff; and more technical emergency responses required a more solid framework to support the operations. The 1978 Act seemed to be outdated and non-applicable to the changing tides.

Since 2012, the Services began drafting a new Bill – Tonga Fire and Emergency Services Bill in association with Murdoch Law Firm from Sydney, Australia. Furthermore, South Australia Metropolitan Fire Services (SAMFS) and local stakeholders were involved through consultations concerning the proposed changes to the legislation.

In October 2014, the Bill was presented for the first time in-front of the Law Committee. Once approval from the Law Committee were satisfied, Parliament of the day heard the Bill and subsequently through Cabinet Decision No.931 dated 14th November 2014, "Cabinet approves and declares the Tonga Fire & Emergency Services Act 2014 come into force with effective from date of Cabinet Decision"

The Act now provides are wider spectrum of Service delivery and a clearer foundation of powers to enact internal and external policies. Such was missing from the previous Act in which the Services relied on Tonga Police policies to fill in the gaps that were missing. However, the Act now confers greater powers and allows the Services to be more effective in its development looking into the foreseeable future.

Acknowledgements are considered for everyone that was involved in this historical milestone.

Operational Activities

Tonga Fire & Emergency Services responded to a total of 406 emergency incidents during the year which is an increase by 88 incidents (27.7%) compared to the previous year.

These are categorised by the type of emergency incidents as shown below:

Structural Fires: Of the total emergency incidents, 98 were for structural fires which are an increase of 42% from the previous year. Structural fires include residential, commercial and industrial fires.

Bush Fire: A total of 193 calls for assistance for bush fires were responded to by the Services throughout the Kingdom of Tonga. Statistically speaking, 47.1% of all responses were attributed to bush fires which are nearly half of all calls. Interestingly, this is a 60% increase in comparison to the previous year. This may be attributed to the El Nino effect that the Kingdom of Tonga experienced during much of 2014.

Other Fires: These other fires cover fires attributed to rubbish heaps, electricity origins etc. A slight decrease of 83 fire calls when compared to the previous of 86 fire calls.

Special Services: There was a total of 6 special call outs responded to the Services. This was the same of the previous year.

False Alarm: False alarm calls are classified as those of that are directly reported and been found later to be false. This includes electronic smoke alarm detection systems which through the process of ill maintenance are activated and the Services responds. The statistics show a 26% decrease in comparison to the previous year.





As the statistics indicates, the Services were very busy responding to fire calls across the nation in 2014. The weather pattern of El Nino were prevalent and is most likely the most contributing factor to the record high number of bush fires responses. The dryness of the land, air and wind meant that bush fires were generally spread in a fast manner and most times uncontrollable. Structural Fires shall be noted recording a record high in response to structural fires.

Despite the record high numbers of responses to fire incidents, the Operations and Suppression division were also busy in the community conducting safety drills with the relevant stakeholders.

Emergency Response

After being established on September 4th 2013, the Emergency Response Division was thrusted into action throughout much of 2014 in their maiden year.

1) Tropical Cyclone Ian.

Category 5, Tropical Cyclone Ian descended upon the Ha'apai Islands on the eve of January 11th 2014 causing widespread havoc and displacing thousands of local residents of Ha'apai.

The Emergency Response Team was dispatched on January 12th 2014 from Tongatapu to aid in the recovery and relief to the people of Ha'apai. Upon arrival, the team settled in got straight into work by supporting other Emergency Response and Relief agencies on the ground.

The presence of the Emergency Response Team was well noted amongst the people of Ha'apai in which they were acknowledged numerous times.

On February 12th 2014, after one month of service to the people of Ha'apai, the Emergency Response team returned to Tongatapu to resume duty as normal.

2) Flood mitigation at Tongataeapa area.

From March to April 2014, Tongatapu experienced major rainfall. As a result, the Tongataeapa/Kolomotu'a area experienced flooding. This is a low laying area and so the floods dampened homes making this area inaccessible to the residents of the area.

In collaboration with the National Emergency Management Office (NEMO), the Emergency Response Team together with NEMO set up Flood Mitigation Operations to the area by transporting the excess water to the nearest sea.

Pumps and hoses (extending several hundered metres) were set up transporting all excess water from the area to the water front at Sopu coast line.

3) Water Delivery to the people of Ha'apai

El Nino affected much of the Kingdom bringing a very dry season leaving many residents with empty rain water tanks. This meant that a drought was looming.

The people of Ha'apai pleaded to NEMO for assistance as many of the tanks across the Ha'apai Islands were empty. In collaboration with NEMO, the Emergency Response Team were deployed to the Ha'apai Islands in December 2014 to deliver drinking water from Tongatapu to Ha'apai and once in Ha'apai, deliver water to water tanks both residential and town tanks.

All together a total of 70,000litres of water was delivered to the people of Ha'apai.


Fire Safety Inspection

Inspections to businesses and industrial premises are one of the key functions of the Community Safety Unit. A total of 284 inspections were carried out which is an increase from 194 of the previous year. The statistics for inspections is dependent on business and industrial premises requesting inspections including the outer islands.

A total of 199 maps including both commercial and private buildings were submitted to Tonga Fire & Emergency Services for fire safety examination prior to being issued a building permit in pursuant to the Building Code.

In collaboration with Town officers and Religious leaders in the Community, the Division was able to successfully deliver Fire Safety posters to be stuck in the main Town and Church Halls.

The following have been identified as areas that affect the delivery of our Services. They are but not limited to:


- Insufficient manpower;
- Lack of reticulated water or physical water supplies for firefighting purposes in small villages;
- Lack of functioning water hydrants across the Nuku'alofa region;
- Delayed reporting of fires from fire scene;
- Lack of street names for easy identification of the fire scene;
- Lack of technical gadgets for when calls for assistance are made;
- Remoteness of over villages from Fire Stations;
- Lack of firefighting equipment which includes hoses;
- Insufficient funds allocated by the Government for the effective administration and operation of the Services;
- Lack of vehicles for daily administrative operations;
- Lack of awareness of emergency number despite effective community programmes;
- Lack of building infrastructure available for Services; and
- Lack of Training facilities and equipment for Fire Fighters

Conclusion

One of the major milestones of the Services for 2014 was the enactment of the Act – Tonga Fire & Emergency Services 2014. This legislation was aimed at producing gap fillers that the Services journeyed together with since the old Act became dated. Special mention and thanks to all the Staff and stakeholders who were involved in this process for all their patience.

The newly established Emergency Response Division was immediately put to the test throughout its maiden year. Despite the obstacles, I am very proud that this new Division fulfilled the vision and the direction in which the Services are heading. All year I have received positive feedback from the communities.

El Nino descended upon the nation for much of 2014. This meant that droughts, dry lands and vegetation made it easier for the spread of fire especially in the tax allotments. This El Nino presented two challenges: 1) the increase in bush fires; and 2) fire appliances were used to deliver drinking water across the Kingdom. Despite this, I am very proud that the Services were able to rise to occasion and met these heavy demands.

In general the Fire Statistics were on the increase in comparison to previous years and despite our best intentions and efforts to educate the general public about Fire safety awareness and prevention – we still cannot prevent fires from occurring. However, we are nonetheless still dedicated to spread fire awareness and prevention techniques.

Despite the many problems affecting the Services, I am never short of being surprised by the dedicated men and women that strive to deliver the most competent service while at the same time appreciating the limited resources that the Services has to operate.

I take this opportunity to thank our stakeholders and other Government departments for the working relationship throughout 2014. Many things were made possible due to our interoperability. Special acknowledgment is due to the Government of South Australia and SAMFS for all their positive contributions for the development of the Service.

Thank you to the former Minister – Honourable Siosifa Tu'utafaiva for his support and guidance during 2014.

Apologies are sought for any shortfalls on behalf of the Services.
